Get Involved

There is a five-step process for bringing the **No Man Left Behind Conference** to your area:

1. **Create an "A-Team"** or Advocacy Team. Recruit at least five passionate leaders from three churches to determine the feasibility of being able to support a local conference.
2. With the A-Team working with a Man in the Mirror ministry consultant, we will plan a **pre-conference "Fishers of Men" dinner** at a local restaurant and invite leaders to attend. There, we will discuss men's discipleship, the need for training, and determine the interest level for a conference.
3. **Secure a date and venue**--usually a local church--that can host a conference for up to 100 leaders, as well as provide a team to provide logistical support. The date should be 4-6 months after the dinner.
4. Working with MIM and the local A-Team, **promote the conference** through both the leaders that attend the dinner and other relationships in the area.
5. **The event happens!** Working together, we will conduct the premier men's leadership conference available, revolutionizing the way attending churches disciple their men for Christ!
